FINANCIAL POLICY FOR REVISIONS & COMPLICATIONS

REVISIONS & COMPLICATIONS

Every plastic and reconstructive surgeon cares for some patients who need a revision or experience a complication requiring additional surgery. As you have been — or will be — told, no result can be guaranteed. In cosmetic procedures, certain problems occur statistically no matter how skilled and careful the surgeon and team. Examples include bleeding or an unfavorable scar following a procedure. In either case it may be necessary to return to surgery, either on an emergency basis (as with bleeding) or an elective basis (as with scarring).

Courtesy to our patients. As a predetermined courtesy, we do not charge a surgeon's fee for complications or revisional surgery within **12 months** of the original surgery date.

ANESTHESIA & FACILITY FEES MAY STILL APPLY

This courtesy applies to the **surgeon's professional fee**. Anesthesia and facility fees are billed separately and, in most cases, are **not waived** — anesthesia is charged by the anesthesia provider for medications, monitoring, and clinician time, and the facility fee covers the cost of running the operating suite (nursing staff, supplies, sterilization, and equipment). You remain responsible for these and for any other hospital or outpatient expenses. Some insurance policies cover revisions or complications, depending on how the policy is written; when you are insured, the surgeon's and facility fees are billed to your insurer.

Whenever a revision or complication requires additional care, our team will review the anticipated facility and anesthesia costs with you in advance, so there are no surprises. If you have insurance, we encourage you to confirm your coverage for revision or complication care with your carrier before scheduling — our staff is glad to help you understand your estimate.

We hope no complication arises and that no revisional surgery is necessary in your case; however, no plastic surgeon can guarantee this. It is important for every patient undergoing an elective procedure to understand this financial policy. If you have any questions, our office staff would be glad to discuss them with you.



CANCELLATION & RESCHEDULING

If for any reason you need to cancel or reschedule your surgery, the following policy applies:

TIMEFRAME	POLICY
More than 2 weeks before	Reschedule: no fee or penalty. Cancel: the \$1,000 deposit may be applied toward services provided by the doctor.
Within 2 weeks	Reschedule: a \$500 rescheduling fee applies. Cancel: forfeit of the \$1,000 deposit.
Same day as surgery	50% of the total cost of the procedure is forfeited.
